Primary Objectives:

- Provide high quality laboratory and technical support to clinical trials

Key Accountabilities / Responsibilities:

- Preparation and processing of blood, urine and other tissue samples.
- Shipment of specimen to dedicated laboratories for analysis
- To perform and specialize in analytical and/or other technical procedures if required.
- Development of procedure and laboratory log forms in compliance with GCP/GLP/GMP and company policies
- Compiling and reporting of results.
- Work close with Clinical Study Coordinators and Head of Clinical Coordination
- Ensure laboratory work environment is always kept in a clean and safe condition in compliance with relevant regulations.
- Ensures that all study related activities are carried out according to Unit and corporate SOPs/ POLs and regulations, GCP/GLP/GMP guidelines and regulatory requirements to meet the regulatory requirements.
- Flexibility and willingness to work as required to meet timelines (i.e. early hours, after hours, and weekends)

Competencies:

- High level of laboratory skills especially in the area of blood and urine sampling and processing.
- Experience in laboratory procedures, safety and quality control
- Knowledge of GLP and preferably GCP/GMP

- Ability to accept responsibility for tasks to work independently when required and to be part of a team

- Flexibility and willingness to work as required to meet timelines
- High level of written and verbal communication skills
